

Tariff Changes in 2011

This year heralds a number of electricity tariff changes as a result of new initiatives to give customers greater control over how they manage their electricity use. As a result CitiPower and Powercor's range of tariffs have been streamlined and simplified.

New customers and existing customers wanting to change their supply characteristics or requiring additional services will also notice some tariffs are being phased out. The main area of change will affect customers with dedicated circuits and controlled load installations. Existing customers with slab heating or Powercor's Climate Saver reverse cycle air conditioning tariff who change their supply characteristics will require rewiring work to be done at their own cost by a Registered Electrical Contractor (REC). For example customers may require a contactor and timer to control their slab heating if they change their tariff or supply characteristics.

Smart meter rollout

Existing customers, including those receiving a smart meter as part of the smart meter rollout, will remain on their current tariffs.
